- I. What is the Bible -
  - A. it is the Christian's Handbook from God
  - B. it is God speaking to you
  - C. it is the Holy Scriptures 2Timothy 3:16
  - D. it is the Word of God
  - E. The word Bible comes from Latin word Biblios which means "the Book"
- II. Make Up of the Bible
  - A. The Bible is made up of 66 different books written by 40+ writers over more than 1500 years, in 3 different languages yet, it fits together into one cohesive story with a central character, and a consistent theme.
  - B. It has 2 divisions Old Testament and New Testament With 39 books in the old testament and 27 in the New testament
  - C. There are 2 main themes of the Bible
    - 1. God revealing Himself to us who God is, His character and His nature
    - 2. Reveals God's plan of redemption of man through Jesus Christ.

- III. The proper approach toward the Bible
  - A. Don't read the Bible like any other book, novel, manual, biography, or history book, etc. in the sense that it only contains information.
  - B. The Bible is God's Word and it is alive and powerful. Hebrews 4:12
  - C. Jesus tells us the Word is like a seed. Mark 4:3-20
    - 1. The Word is to be planted into a persons heart (the soil) You plant the Word in your heart by reading and hearing it.
    - 2. The condition of the heart (soil) determines the harvest of the Word in a persons life either 30 60 or 100 fold.
    - 3. The harvest of the seed of God's Word is the "substance" in the Word we have heard joy, peace, direction, etc.
      - just like the harvest of a corn seed is corn the substance in the that seed.
    - 4. The Word has the substance of everything we need in life and for Godliness. 2Peter 1:3
